- Work orders can have up to 999 releases, each indicating a different quantity, due date, customer and sales order.

- Inventory committed and on-order quantities are updated as soon as firm orders are released and exploded, providing the most accurate status of inventory availability.

- You can choose to cost your products using material costs only, or full absorption, with updates to Inventory made to either actual and standard values. Both actual and standard are maintained all the way through history for comparative analysis.

- If you choose to interface to General Ledger, complete accounting updates are made, including material pulls to WIP, applied labor and overhead, finished good costing and cost and quantitative variances.

- The Edit Requirements function provides complete editing of the individual requirements for exploded work orders. You can delete and insert components, assemblies or processes, and edit quantities, routings and lead times even for in-process orders - perfectly suited for last minute engineering or customer order changes.

- The Parts Requisition and Lot Traveler are provided as source documents for material pulls and assembly routing.
- The Issue Requirements function is used to report manufacturing activity to the software. Extreme flexibility has been provided, allowing individual product pulls, exception only backflushing, standard or time-clock style time entry for labor and machine times and the option to process level-by-level.
- Optional interfaces to Payroll and Purchase Order provide the ability to post time gathered in manufacturing to employee payroll records, and to gather product receipt information from purchasing.
